Description of Proposal: The review and adoption of the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) is a state requirement and will implement the goals, policies, design criteria and land use maps of the comprehensive plans and transportation element in accordance with RCW 36.70 and 36.70A. The City of West Richland's 2020-2025 Six Year Transportation Improvement Program includes 27 project proposals. The list includes projects which are both funded and unfunded, motorized and non-motorized.
