A. For a three-fourths-inch meter or one-inch meter: \$1,500 for the service connection; provided, that in the event the city's only requirement is to insert a meter into a properly constructed meter box, the fee shall be \$430.00. The three-fourths-inch meter will be issued only with the approval of the public works director

The aforementioned hookup fees exclude the cost of asphalt pavement concrete curb and gutter, landscaping and sidewalk restoration. A fee for restoration shall be in addition to the hookup fee.

B. For a one-and-one-half-inch meter: \$2,675 for the meter and service connection; provided, that in the event the city's only requirement is to insert a meter into a properly constructed meter box, the fee shall be \$725.00. The aforementioned hookup fees exclude the cost of asphalt pavement, concrete curb and gutter, landscaping and sidewalk restoration. A fee for restoration shall be in addition to the hookup fee.

C. For a two-inch meter: \$3,290 for the meter and service connection; provided, that in the event the city's only requirement is to insert a meter into a properly constructed meter box, the fee shall be \$950.00. The aforementioned hookup fees exclude the cost of asphalt pavement, concrete curb and gutter, landscaping and sidewalk restoration. A fee for restoration shall be in addition to the hook up fee.
