Reserving a garden plot can be done in person, by mail or email through the Community Development Office. Mail or drop off applications at 3100 Belmont Blvd Suite 104 West Richland, WA, Monday through Friday, 8am-12 noon and 1pm-5pm. Email applications to parks@westrichland.org. The cost is nonrefundable.

Each household is allowed one garden plot, but can be placed on the waitlist for additional plots. Plot assignments will be announced on March 2, 2020. Assignments are made on a first-come, first-serve basis. Gardeners may begin preparing their assigned plot once plot assignments are announced.
