Paradise Way & Belmont Blvd Intersection Revisions

In preparation for the new elementary school on Sunshine Avenue opening for the 2019-2020 school year, the city's engineering staff with assistance from JUB Engineers evaluated the intersection of Paradise Way and Belmont Blvd. The analysis focused on safety for pedestrian crossings at this intersection.

The results determined that an all-way stop situation would provide for safer pedestrian crossings at the intersection while maintaining an acceptable level of service for vehicular traffic.

During the week of June 17th, the City's maintenance crew will be modifying the Paradise Way and Belmont Blvd. intersection into a four-way stop intersection. Advance warning signs with flags will also be installed to alert drivers of the intersection revisions.
