Following are allowable dates and times for fireworks use.

- ❖ July 2nd & 3rd Between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.
- ❖ July 4th Between 6:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight
- ❖ December 31st Between 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. January 1st

Fireworks are banned in all city parks and school property, including parking lots.

Selection of Design/Build Team for New Police Facility

On June 2nd the West Richland City Council approved a phase one contract with the design/build team selected for construction of the new police facility.

After a thorough and stringent selection process the design/build team of Chervenell Construction, Design West Architects and TreanorHL Architects were designated as best valued team to proceed with the project.

Chervenell Construction, who will lead the team, is based out of Kennewick and have over 40 years of construction experience in the Tri-Cities, including West Richland. They have partnered with Design West Architects, based in Utah, who will operate out of their Kennewick office. Design West has also enlisted TreanorHL Architects to assist with the design because of their nationwide experience specifically related to police facilities.

The design phase of the facility has already begun and the facility is scheduled for a completion date of December 1, 2021. The location for the new facility will be on Van Giesen just south of Keene. We look forward to working with this team and the successful completion of the new police facility.
