In order to better serve our community, the City of West Richland has the capability to use a direct notification system to alert customers of high priority billing or service related items. This system will allow the City to provide timely public notifications including information about the water system. Notifications may be sent out via e-mail, text message, and/or phone call.

To ensure our system is updated with the most current customer contact information, please take a moment to complete the "Contact Update" form below and return it with your payment. Customers can also send an e-mail with all information to utilities@westrichland.org.

Tenants and Landlords: It is at the property owner's discretion whose phone number is entered to receive notifications. If a renter opts to have their phone number on the account it is their responsibility to notify us when they move out so contact information can be removed.

Fireworks - Dates and times allowed.

WRMC 8.22.020

Fireworks may be sold in the incorporated areas of the city of West Richland during the period commencing at 12:00 noon on the twenty-eighth day of June of each year and ending at 12:00 noon on the sixth day of July of each year. Fireworks may only be discharged during the following periods:

July 2nd through July 3rd

Between 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 pm.

July 4th

Between 6:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight


December 31st

Between 6:00 p.m. and 1:00 a.m. January 1st

Fireworks - Discharge - Rules and regulations.


WRMC 8.22.030

- A. It is unlawful to use, fire or discharge any fireworks along the route of or during any parade, or at any place of public assembly or in any commercial use district.
- B. It is unlawful at any time to throw or toss any fireworks at any person, animal, vehicle or other thing or object.
- C. It is unlawful to smoke within 25 feet of any building or stand in which fireworks are sold at retail or are stored after hours.
- D. It is unlawful to discharge fireworks within 100 feet of any retail fireworks stand.
- E. All other rules and regulations of the State Fire Marshal relating to fireworks, Chapter [70.77](#) RCW, State Fireworks Law, including, but not limited to, rules and regulations adopted pursuant to Chapter [70.77](#) RCW, shall be followed.
- F. It is unlawful to have in possession, use, fire or discharge any fireworks in any public park within the city of West Richland including vehicle parking areas within said parks.
- G. It is unlawful to cause damage to the property of another as a result of discharging or storage of fireworks under your control.
- H. It is unlawful for any person to discharge fireworks on the property of another without a proof of permission of the owner of such property. Any rights-of-way adjacent to the owner's property is considered the owner's property for the purposes of this section.

All public parks within the City of West Richland, including the vehicle parking areas, are closed to the general public between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.


No person except an authorized employee of the City of West Richland, and any on-duty, commissioned police officer, shall be in any city park during the hours of closure.

The hours of operation of a public park may be extended by issuance of a special permit from the city.
