Chief of Police, Ben Majetich, Retires

After a 34 year career in law enforcement, with 8 serving the citizens of West Richland, Police Chief Ben Majetich has retired from law enforcement. Chief Majetich spent about 26 years of his career with the Pasco Police Department. He worked in many roles throughout his career, including street patrol, SWAT, defense tactics instructor and investigations. Majetich transferred to the West Richland Police Department in 2014, taking the position of Captain. In 2016, he was promoted to Chief of Police. Chief Majetich was instrumental in the construction of the new Police Facility that opened its doors to the public in January of this year. After retirement from



law enforcement, Chief Majetich intends to continue his service to the community with Adult Protective Services.

Police Captain Thomas Grego was named the next Chief of Police, and was promoted on May 23rd.

Message from Animal/Code Compliance:

It is that time of the year where lawn maintenance is a common sight, and property owners are out and about. It is also that time where “fire hazard complaints” begin to make a presence in my work load. Reminder, weeds/vegetation must be trimmed down under 6 inches per our WRMC 8.16.030 Specific nuisances- Vegetation and debris. If your property is larger than 2.2 acres, a 20-foot fire break is required at the point where the parcel adjoins developed property and five-feet where it adjoins an improved public right of way (sidewalk, street, etc.) You may be subject to a \$250 fine for a 1st offense if you fail to correct a violation. I have several of these complaints open/in progress at this time. If you wish to report a property, you can give me a call at 509-967-7112. Thanks and stay safe!

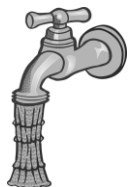
