Message from ACCO regarding noise complaints:

We are now mid-summer, where our West Richland citizens are enjoying their property morning, afternoon, and evening. During this time, I am also receiving plenty of noise complaints- whether coming from an animal or a loud speaker at a party.

This is a reminder: I cannot enforce our WRMC ordinances regarding noise if you remain "anonymous" when you submit a complaint. I must have an identifiable complainant per our enforcement ordinance.

If noise from another property is bothering you or your family, I encourage you to let the involved neighbor know that the noise is an issue – only if you are safely able to do so. Many times when I respond to these complaints, the homeowner is unaware the noise is an issue for their fellow neighbors. I hear often that they would have corrected the problem if it was brought to their attention in the first place, without my involvement.
