The City held an open house for the referenced project Wednesday, November 16, 2022 from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm at the Tapteal Elementary School gym (Flyer attached). The following agencies were in attendance:

We have received one comment card and one comment through the website created for the project. The City had an interpreter in attendance as well as provided the comment cards in both English and Spanish.

The open house had two stations both showing the same design layout for the roadway, pathways, sidewalks and transit stops from Antinori Road to just west of Bombing Range Road. The project flyer was made available to attendees.

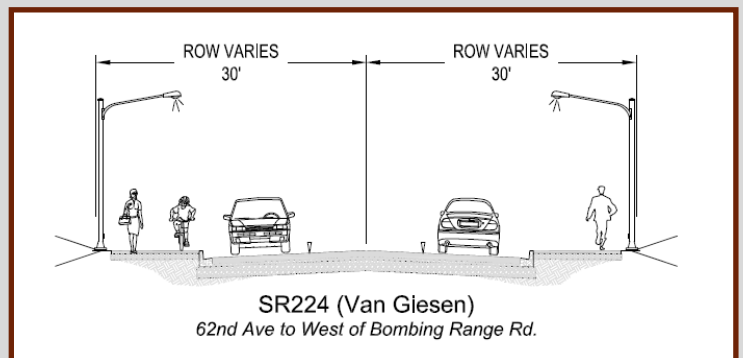
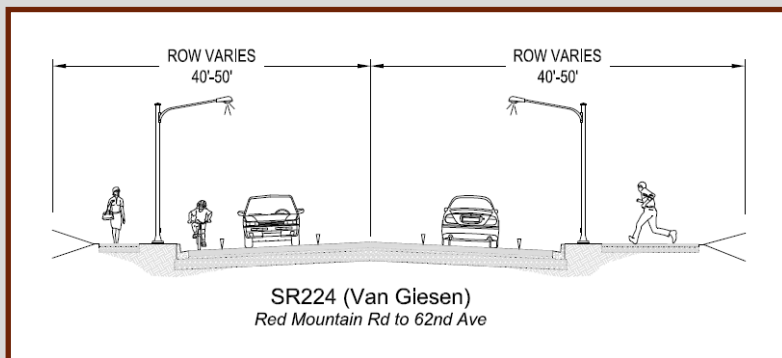

SR 224/Red Mountain Improvements After an analysis of current and forecasted needs for the Red Mountain area, the City of West Richland and the Washington State Department of Transportation have identified improvements to the SR 224 corridor. These improvements would be an effective investment to address the growing needs in the Red Mountain area.

The project would improve traffic operations for vehicles, add active transportation facilities for bicycles and pedestrians, and improve intersections within the SR 224 corridor.

These proposed improvements, along with the completed local investments, will provide the infrastructure needed to address future access and capacity needs and ensure residential, commercial and industrial growth continues in the West Richland and surrounding Red Mountain area.
