Things to Remember on Garbage Day

Don't forget about garbage day! Early in the morning on the day of pickup (or the night before), remember to:

1. Fill your cart and set it out at curbside.

Bag up your trash and place it into the cart for disposal. Make sure your cart is completely full before placing any additional items 3 feet from the container. Once it's full, if you still have more waste for us to pick up, see Step #2. Please note that the weight of the container must not exceed 180 pounds.

A 96-gallon wheeled cart is included with your service. New customers should receive their cart within 7 days of requesting service.

2. Do you have extra stuff for us to pick up? BAG IT, BOX IT, BUNDLE IT and we will pick it up at no extra charge to you!!!

Remember to place your garbage cart on the street and not on the sidewalk whenever possible.

If your cart is full and you still have more waste for us to pick up, you can place it in qualified bins, bags, or bundles alongside the main cart for disposal. Just remember to follow these guidelines to avoid extra fees:

- Waste must be properly “bagged, boxed or bundled” so that it can be lifted by a crew member.
- The weight must not exceed 65 lbs. per bag, box or bundle or exceed 2 feet by 2 feet by 5 feet in dimension.
- If you are bundling woody material, the individual limb diameters must be smaller than 6 inches.
- Place items 3 feet from your container so our workers can collect them.
- If you use a personal garbage can or cart, make sure it's 32 gallons or less in size. Note that the 65 pound weight limit still applies.

Again, remember to fill your cart FIRST. If we see “extra” waste alongside that could have fit in the main cart, an additional fee will be billed.

Do you regularly have more waste than fits in your primary cart? We highly encourage renting additional carts, and are able to offer them at a steep discount. The modern trucks we use in our fleet are designed to collect our 96 gallon carts automatically, making our route more efficient and ultimately saving our customers money.

3. Treat yard waste just like your trash!

Yard waste disposal is included at no additional charge as long as it is bagged and placed in the primary cart, or properly bagged or bundled and placed alongside it just like other extra waste.

Grass clippings, weeds, you name it – all yard waste can go in your primary cart as long as it is bagged up first (do not place loose grass clippings in the cart).

The same weight and size limits apply as for all other extra waste in Step 2. If guidelines for yard waste are not followed, an additional charge for collection will apply.

4. Have something BIG to dispose of? Help us plan ahead.

Our regular trucks are able to accommodate most large household items, such as old furniture or mattresses – just place them next to your cart at curbside like any other extra waste and we'll pick them up.

However, certain items can't go directly into the waste stream because of potential health or environmental hazards. If you have one of the following items for us to pick up, please call ahead of time at (509) 547-2476 to let us know that you have a special item for disposal such as:

- Televisions
- Water heaters
- Large appliances

We will ensure that the items are picked up and that hazardous materials are disposed of in a safe and responsible manner.

Items containing Freon, such as refrigerators, air conditioners, and freezers will incur an additional charge for the safe removal of the Freon.

Personal car tires can be collected along with other large solid waste, with certain restrictions. Only tires from a customer's private car may be collected – truck and tractor tires are excluded. If a customer is disposing of more waste tires than a typical residence would generate, the excessive use will trigger additional charges (see rate sheet).

Limited Service for Low-Income Customers

A smaller, 64-gallon waste cart is available at a discount for qualified low-income customers, and certain limitations apply.

Under the discounted service program, a 64-gallon collection cart will be provided. All waste must fit in the cart, and extra waste is not permitted. Additional charges will apply for disposal of yard waste or other solid waste placed at the curb adjacent to the collection cart.

To qualify for the low-income discount program, you must meet certain requirements. For more information regarding this program, and to determine eligibility, please contact the City of West Richland at 509-967-3431 or email utilities@westrichland.org.

If we determine that a discount customer routinely sets out more waste than may be contained in the 64-gallon cart, the discount may be lost and the customer will revert to regular Unlimited Residential Service with the larger 96-gallon cart at standard rates (see rate sheet).
