BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On an annual basis, the Public Works Department Staff updates the City's Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The program outlines the funded and planned capital roadway improvement projects throughout the City. Projects on the program are eligible for local, state and federal funds. The 2020 – 2025 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program was adopted by Council on June 18, 2019 following a public hearing (Resolution 22-19). As circumstances change, the program can be amended by a majority of the City Council following a public hearing (RCW 35.77.010) as long as the amendments to the program are consistent with the City's adopted Comprehensive Plan.

SUMMARY:

Public Works staff is proposing the following amendments to the 2020-2025 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP):

- 1) Bombing Range Road / Keene Road Intersection Modifications Project (Priority #4) is currently shown on the City's adopted 2020-2025 TIP. The proposed amendment would modify the project's funding to recognize a recently awarded \$237,875 Federal STP-UL grant for the design, environmental permitting and road row acquisition, as needed. Construction funding for this project has not been secured at this time.

The City's TIP needs to be amended before the City can obligate the newly awarded federal grants. The projects tentative schedule is to begin design, environmental permitting, and road row acquisition, as needed in spring of 2020.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Council adopt the resolution amending the City's 2020-2025 Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program.
